➤ Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary was edited using the material contained in the excellent lexicographic work, which is the eleven-volume Słownik staropolski [Old Polish Dictionary] (1953-2002) created under the editorship of Stanisław Urbańczyk and based on the Słownik staropolski. Suplement [Old Polish Dictionary. Supplement] part 1 (verba absentia) (2014) edited by Ewa Deptuchowa.

Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] was created as part of a team project grant of the National Science Centre in 2011-2015. Version 1.0 of the Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] was released on the Internet in 2015.

After the completion of the grant, the project Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] has been developed systematically. Onomasiological works related to the lexical content of individual conceptual categories of this dictionary were conducted at the Institute of the Polish Language of the Polish Academy of Sciences, as a result of which its structure was modified.

► The material basis of the onomasiological Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] online is 22,735 entry articles from the Słownik staropolski [Old Polish Dictionary] and 1151 entries from its supplement. Within these entry articles there is the oldest Polish vocabulary from the 12<sup>th</sup> century to the end of the 15<sup>th</sup> century.

► The Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] online includes the full structure of the entries from the Šłownik staropolski [Old Polish Dictionary] and its supplement, so this dictionary includes both units with a full lexicographic description, i.e. those with a definition or description of functions, and incomplete units, which in the Słownik staropolski [Old Polish Dictionary] and its supplement have no editorial description. Within 23,886 entry articles of the Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] there are 54,038 lexical units.

► The lexical content of the Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary], is shown in a conceptual, alphabetical and grammatical order.

▶ The basis for its creation was the classification scheme developed by R. Hallig and W. von Wartburg for modern French vocabulary, presented in the book Begriffssystem als Grundlage für die Lexikographie. Versuch eines Ordnungsschemas (1952, 1963). This conceptual plan and the modifications were conditioned by the semantics of the analysed Old Polish material.

- The current scheme of the Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] (2020) consists of 3 first-order categorization levels:
- ▶ 1.UNIVERSE and WORLD
- ▶ 2. HUMAN
- ▶ 3. HUMAN and UNIVERSE and WORLD.

The classification scheme of the Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary] currently contains (2020) 80,594 semantic units, i.e. assignments of lexical units to this structure. The medieval lexis is most frequently represented by vocabulary in the field of human social life (39,802 semantic units, i.e. almost 50% of the entire lexical resource analysed), which results from the thematic content of language relics subjected to extraction by the editors of the Słownik staropolski [Old Polish Dictionary] and its supplement.

# The further work on the development of Słownik pojęciowy języka staropolskiego [Conceptual Old Polish Dictionary]

The aim of these analyses is to work out an optimal structure in which the necessary and sufficient concepts will be found due to the analysed medieval material—and within which all lexical units will be assigned to appropriate concepts structured according to the accepted principles.
